

EXTENDED WARRANTY POLICY

Cinema Products

Effective date: March 1, 2020

Definitions

Unless otherwise defined in this extended warranty policy, capitalized terms used in this extended warranty policy have the meaning given to such terms in the Base Warranty.

"Base Warranty" means the Christie Standard Limited Warranty (Cinema Products) applicable to the Extended Warranty Product as was in force at the date the End User purchased, leased or licensed the Extended Warranty Product;

"Base Warranty Period" means warranty period for the Extended Warranty Product stated in the Base Warranty;

"Extended Warranty Certificate" means the extended warranty certificate issued by Christie with respect to the Extended Warranty Product;

"Extended Warranty Commencement Date" means the commencement date of the Extended Warranty Period;

"Extended Warranty Period" means the extended warranty period for the Extended Warranty Product; and

"Extended Warranty Product" means the Product that is subject to the extended warranty pursuant to this extended warranty policy.

Policy

End User may purchase an extended warranty from Christie to provide warranty coverage for the Products after the warranty period set forth in the Base Warranty. Unless otherwise stated in, or supplemented by, the Extended Warranty Certificate, such extended warranty is subject to the same terms and limitations as those set out in the Base Warranty. In the event of any inconsistency between the Base Warranty and the Extended Warranty Certificate, the Extended Warranty Certificate will prevail.

At the option of End User, such extended warranty may be purchased for consecutive one year periods up to a maximum number of years as determined by Christie, such warranty to be purchased on an annual basis for each consecutive year at a fee per year per Product in effect at the time of purchase of such extended warranty.

Each annual extended warranty must be purchased by End User prior to the expiry of the most recent in-force warranty period; otherwise an extended warranty will not be available for any subsequent period unless Christie has evaluated (including operational testing and condition evaluation of the Product at the expense of the End User) or otherwise determined that an extended warranty may be granted.

If Christie grants an extended warranty where the Base Warranty Period and Extended Warranty Period are not contiguous, the extended warranty will not apply to any problem or failure of the Extended Warranty Product that occurs prior to the 90th day after the Extended Warranty Commencement Date.

Each extended warranty will be evidenced by an Extended Warranty Certificate that must be acknowledged and accepted in writing by the End User.

Exclusions

The extended warranty does not cover:

- 1) Problems or damage caused by use of an Extended Warranty Product at an ambient temperature in excess of the Maximum Ambient Temperature at any time during the Base Warranty Period and Extended Warranty Period (and any intervening period if the Base Warranty Period and Extended Warranty Period are not contiguous).
- 2) Problems or damage caused by use of an Extended Warranty Product in a laser driver mode other than the Laser Driver Mode.
- 3) Problems or damage to, or caused by, the integrated media block in any Solaria One model projector.

If the extended warranty has been granted by Christie where the Base Warranty Period and Extended Warranty Period are not contiguous, the extended warranty will not apply to any problem or failure of the Extended Warranty Product that occurs prior to the 90th day after the Extended Warranty Commencement Date.
